- ✨ I am God's VIP!

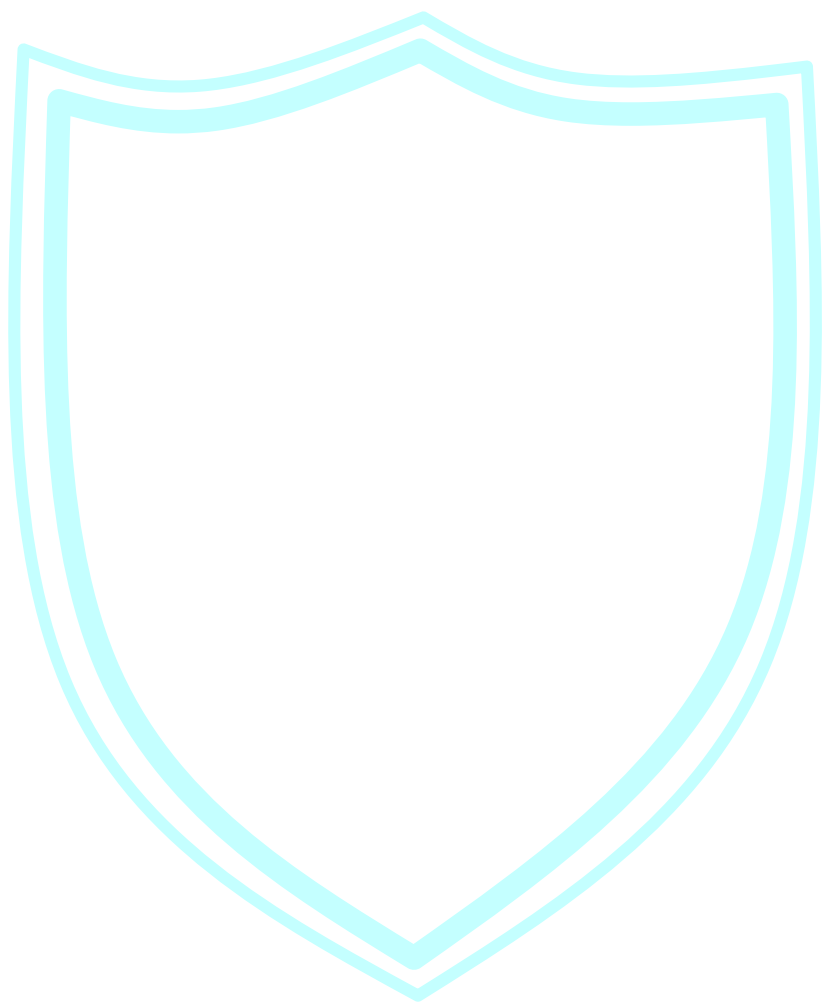


## Draw Your Identity Shield
