# Home Teaching Guide



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## Kingdom Kids Home/Church Lesson Plan

Theme: God Is Working in Me! Age Group: 6–12 Duration: 30–40 minutes

#### **Main Scripture:**

For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases Him." - Philippians 2:13 (NLT)

#### **Lesson Objective:**

Children will learn that:

- God lives and works in them through the Holy Spirit
- They are not doing life alone—they are vessels of God's power
- Speaking God's Word builds boldness and spiritual confidence

### 1. Welcome & Warm-Up (3–5 mins)

#### Ask:

• "Have you ever felt like you couldn't do something on your own?"

• "What if you had God's help—what could you do?"

#### Say:

"Today we're going to learn how God works in us and how we can say what He says so we live strong and full of power!"

#### 2. Object Lesson: The Glove (5–7 mins)

(Optional : Watch video

Materials: A glove and an object to pick up (like a Bible or pen)

#### **Demonstration**:

• Show the empty glove. Ask, "Can this do anything by itself?" (No!)

• Place your hand inside and make the glove wave, grab, or move.

• Say: "Now it works—because there's power inside! That's like you and me. We were made in God's image, but it's God in us that makes us powerful!"

#### Connect it:

"God is the hand, we're the glove. When we let Him fill us, we can do things we couldn't do on our own."

#### 3. Scripture Focus: Philippians 2:13 (5 mins)

#### **Read together:**

"For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases Him."

#### Ask:

- "Who is working in you?" (God!)
- "What is He helping you do?" (Things that please Himlove, be kind, obey, be brave.)

#### Faith Confession Together:

"God is working in me! I can do what pleases Him!"

## 4. Fill-in-the-Faith Confessions Worksheet (15–20 mins)

Instructions:

- Give each child a worksheet or notebook page
- Read the sentence starters aloud

• Help children write their own faith-filled endings based on God's Word or how they see Him working in them

Examples to guide them: (see attached worksheet)

- "God is working in me, so I can forgive."
- "Because I have the Holy Spirit, I can be kind at school."
- "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

## 5. Speak It Out! (5 mins)

Encourage each child to read their favourite 2–3 confessions aloud with boldness.

Say Together:

"I believe what God says, so I speak it! I am full of His power!"

## 6. Wrap-Up Prayer (3 mins)

Pray together:

"Thank You, God, that You are working in me. You help me do what pleases You. I choose to believe and speak Your Word every day. In Jesus' name, Amen!"

## Fill-in-the-Faith Confessions

Did you know? In the Bible, we're told to believe and speak what God says. That's what faith does—it agrees with God and says it out loud!

When you fill in the sentences below, you're writing your own faith confessions —just like a champion who knows that God is working in them.

Instructions:

- 1. Read each sentence starter carefully.
- 2. Think about what God's Word says.
- 3. Write your own faith-filled ending!
- 4. When you're done, read them out loud like you mean it!
